

AAC Student Travel Award Application

The AAC will provide limited travel and expense support to students to allow them to present their research at the AAC's annual conference. Applicants must (1) be registered at a recognized institution of higher learning, (2) present a paper (oral or poster) at the meeting in person, (3) be first author if the paper has several authors, and (4) demonstrate the need for financial assistance. Recipients will be required to volunteer some of their time at the conference. Completed applications must be submitted as a single document, preferably in pdf format, to the Chair of the Awards Committee, Debbie Plouffe, awards@aquacultureassociation.ca. Successful awards will be reimbursed after the conference, upon submission of a claim with original receipts (and boarding passes for flights).
